## Minors' Distribution 2019 Deadlines

If you are or will turn 18 in 2019, then you are eligible to receive your payment from the Minor's Trust upon completion of distribution paperwork.

### **Deadlines for 2019:**

April, May, June birthdays must submit forms by June 28th

July, August, September birthdays must submit forms by September 30th

October, November, December birthdays must submit forms by December 31th

Please return your completed distribution form to the Tribal Enrollment Office before the end of the calendar quarter. Completion includes a clear copy of a photo ID, the Tax Section completed, clear and legible contact information, personal signature and updated address with the Enrollment Office. You can

expect up to two months for the paperwork to process before funds are released.

If your forms are not completed by the appointed deadline, then your application will be held until the next ending quarter. Minors who have an account in the Minors Trust but are not able to return their forms timely will have up to six years to complete their forms and claim their economic stimulus payment. The six years count starts on your 18th birthday.

In order to be eligible for the economic stimulus payment, you must have been enrolled by April 6, 2018.

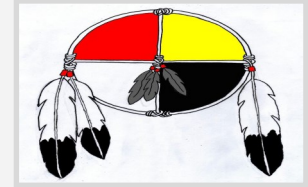
