Family Policy Compliance Office (FPCO) Home

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) (20 U.S.C. § 1232g; 34 CFR Part 99) is a Federal law that protects the privacy of student education records. The law applies to all schools that receive funds under an applicable program of the U.S. Department of Education.

FERPA gives parents certain rights with respect to their children's education records. These rights transfer to the student when he or she reaches the age of 18 or attends a school beyond the high school level. Students to whom the rights have transferred are "eligible students."

What is it that our Consolidated Higher Education Program wants to accomplish!

- Career Counseling, to assist the High School Guidance Counselor in providing information in any career opportunity that a student is interested in or pursuing.
- Scheduling Student and Parent Workshops, on subject matter to help student(s) in maneuvering thru their high school years and on into College or an Adult Vocational Training Institution.
- Inform our Tribal high school students on how to apply for our Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Scholarships; along with providing other information on how to apply for other scholarships that may pertain to the career goals.

If you would like to have your student to participate, please fill out the permission form and either mail, email, fax, or drop the form off at the Pyramid Lake Tribal Administration Office. They will route the form back to our Consolidated Higher Education Office.
